

# Water Rescue Seminar

This year the Central Ontario Newfoundland Dog Club will hold its Water Rescue Seminar on May 28<sup>th</sup> & May 29<sup>th</sup> at Guelph Lake Conservation Area. The two day class is for beginners as well as for those who have already had experience with water work.

We are thrilled to have Deanna Alko coming to Ontario to instruct this year. Deanna has led many water rescue dog training seminars for Newfoundland Dog clubs throughout the US and is an excellent instructor. She will ensure your Newf has a positive experience and help them advance whether never having entered the water before or getting ready to title.

You and your dog will begin to learn the elements of water rescue which include retrieving (you will have a chance to practice this both on land and in the water), pulling a boat to shore, jumping off a boat into the water and rescuing a drowning victim.

Working together to learn new skills is a wonderful bonding experience for you and your Newf. Water work is particularly enjoyable because it brings out the natural skills and instincts that are inherent in this wonderful breed.

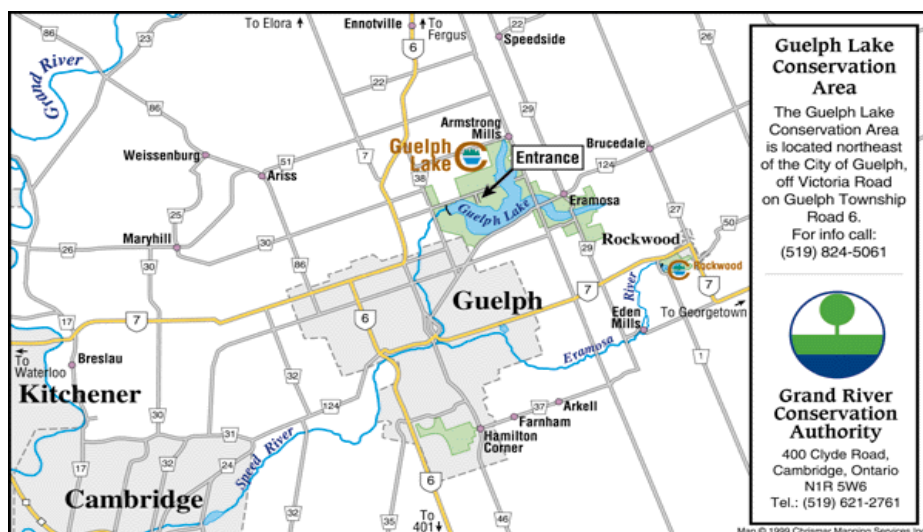
## What to Bring:

**For You:** DOT approved life jacket  
Bathing suit, towel, change of clothes  
Appropriate shoes to wear in the water

**For Your Newf:** collar and 6 foot nylon leash  
Canvas retrieving toy (bumper)  
Treats and water bowl  
A Crate

Newfs must be at least four months old to participate.

**NOTE: NO LIFEGUARDS** are on duty. Parents are responsible for their children.
