

### **COVID -19 PANDEMIC SAFETY PROTOCOLS**

We will be monitoring the provincial health recommendations closely and believe that decisions should be made considering what the public health authorities are recommending at that time.

**ANY CHANGE IN THE STATUS OF COVID-19, MAY RESULT IN LAST MINUTE CANCELLATION OF THE TESTS & further protocols may be put in place as the event nears to ensure provincial guidelines are followed.**

#### **Our requirements:**

- 1) The waiver provided must accompany your entry.
- 2) NO ONE WITH ANY SIGN OF ILLNESS OR FEVER OR ANY COVID SYMPTOMS, or ANYONE WHO CURRENTLY RESIDES, IS ASSOCIATED WITH OR ARE RELATED TO ANYONE WITH ANY SIGN OF ILLNESS OR FEVER OR ANY COVID SYMPTOMS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE AREA.
- 3) Please bring your own source of shade, food & seating. There will be no food sharing or potluck as has been our previous tradition.
- 4) EVERYONE will respect social distancing and stay at least 2 meters (6 feet) apart at **all times** and **masks/gloves are required** in the rare event that social distancing cannot be maintained.
- 5) A hand sanitizing station will be provided and everyone is expected to clean their hands before and after all interactions. Any common surfaces will be sanitized before & after each event/contact.

Washroom facilities at Guelph Lake CA may be very limited, however maintained flush toilets are available approximately 1 km from the test site, within the park.

## RULES


It shall be the duty and obligation of the test giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Test Committee shall have the authority to take such action it deems necessary to solve the situation. The Canadian Water Rescue Dog Rules are available from the Newfoundland Dog Club of Canada. Entrants are responsible for knowing the NDCC Water Rescue Test rules and regulations for each level entered. These are available for free at the NDCC website: <http://newfoundlanddogclub.ca>.

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## DEFINITION OF CLASSES

Water Rescue Dog Novice and Water Rescue Dog: Open to all Newfoundlands 6 months of age and over on the day of the test, registered with the CKC or eligible for such registration.

Water Rescue Dog Excellent: Open to all Newfoundlands who have previously obtained a Canadian Water Rescue Dog Title

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## AWARDS

Through the generosity of its members and friends the Central Ontario Region, Newfoundland Dog Club of Canada will offer rosettes for each qualifying score. The Central Ontario Region, Newfoundland Dog Club of Canada will present a medallion to each dog who successfully passes all three legs at this test.

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## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Test Chairperson will be in full charge of the tests.

The Central Ontario Newfoundland Dog Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.

Owners or handlers are responsible for clean up after their dogs. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after closing day and time is prohibited.

The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Rules. Telephone entries cannot be accepted except in the case of a postal disruption.

Confirmation of entry and Judging Schedules will be mailed or e-mailed as soon as possible after the closing.

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## QUALIFYING SCORE

To earn a Novice Water Rescue Dog, Water Rescue Dog Title or Water Rescue Dog Excellent Title at these tests the entrant will be required to successfully pass all the exercises as written in the Canadian Water Rescue Dog Test Rules, in the eyes of all three judges.

During the test, the decision of the judges shall be final in all matters affecting the working of dogs and handlers and in evaluation of their performance.

Re-qualifications may be accepted pending space available. Re-qualifications will be judged last in the level they enter.

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## POST ENTRIES

Post entries will be accepted for the WRDX test from those entrants who have qualified for a WRD title at this test; or WRD for those entrants who have qualified for a Novice title. Entries may be limited due to time constraints.

**An additional entry fee will be charged.**

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## EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request to the CKC for a 30-day extension. 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## ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.

To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

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## EQUIPMENT

To be supplied by the entrant

Be prepared for any weather. This event is entirely outdoors and there is no provision for cover in case of inclement weather.

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## BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season may compete, but will be judged after all other entrants have been tested. An entrant may if desired request a refund, less CKC fees for a bitch that has come into season. A veterinarian's certificate will be required before a refund is processed.

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## TRACKING FEE

Effective January 1, 2011 the CKC instituted a tracking fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members. In order to protect any points and awards earned at any CKC event, a resident non-member can choose to become a CKC member or pay the tracking fee of \$62.40 plus HST for each dog. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member
